SOUTHERN (LA.) 37 DELAWARE STATE 27

SEPT. 5, 2010 MEAC/SWAC CHALLENGE
FLORIDA CITRUS BOWL STADIUM | ORLANDO, FLA.

Southern University scored 21 unanswered points in the fourth quarter en route to the victory in the annual MEAC/SWAC Challenge. The Hornets led 27-16 before the Jaguars stormed back to give the SWAC its second win in the six-year history of the contest between teams from the nation's two historically Black Division I college conferences. Southern, which also won the 2007 MEAC/SWAC Challenge, defeated Delaware State for the first time in three games between the teams.

The Southern win overshadowed a career effort by Delaware State's Larrone Moore, who collected 186 all-purpose yards. Moore also became the first Hornet with two touchdowns of 85-or-more yards in a game.

DSU scored first when quarterback Anthony Glaud connected with Darius Jackson on a 16-yard touchdown pass on the opening drive of the game. The extra point kick by freshman Mario Diaz-Aviles gave the Hornets a 7-0 lead with 11:08 left in the first quarter. Glaud was 3-for-3 for 33 yards on the seven-play, 3-minute-52 second scoring drive. Jaashawn Jones had three carries for 33 yards, including a 24-yard run, during the drive.

Southern used a 6-minute-35 second touchdown march to even the game early in the second quarter. Jaguar quarterback Jeremiah McGinty capped off the 16-play drive with an 8-yard touchdown pass to tight end Javon Jordan. The extra point kick by William Griswold tied the game at 7-7 with 14:05 left in the second quarter.

Moore struck for the first time later in the second quarter to put the Hornets back in front. The Hyattsville, Md., native caught a pass from Glaud on a crossing pattern and sprinted untouched 85 yards for a touchdown to give Delaware State a 13-7 lead with 12:24 left in the second quarter. A poor snap prevented the Hornets from converting the extra point following the touchdown. The touchdown catch was Moore's second at Delaware State, and the longest of his career. It was also Glaud's longest career completion.

The Jaguars went on another long march to take the lead for the first time. Halfback Sylvester Nzekwe capped off a 12-play, 75-yard drive with a one-yard touchdown run to tie the score at 13-13 with 3:24 to go. Griswold's extra point kick gave the Jaguars their first lead, 14-13.

It took the Hornets just 13 seconds to regain the lead. Moore took the ensuing kickoff and darted down the left sideline 90 yards for a touchdown to give DSU a 19-14 lead with 3:11 left in the second quarter. Another poor snap by the Hornets on the extra point attempt was scooped up by Southern's Anthony Wells, who returned the ball downfield for two points, cutting Delaware State's lead to 19-16.

The touchdown was Moore's second of his career on a kickoff return. He also had a 90-yard return for a touchdown against South Carolina State in 2009. Moore was selected as Delaware State's Most Valuable Player for the contest.

DSU padded its lead on a touchdown directed by back-up quarterback Nick Elko following a Southern turnover early in the third quarter. Two plays after the Hornets recovered a Jaguar fumble, Elko connected with Justin Wilson on a 38-yard touchdown pass to give the DSU a 27-16 lead with 10:50 remaining in the third quarter. It was Elko's first touchdown throw and Wilson's first TD catch. Elko entered the game in the final minute of the second quarter after Glaud went down with a knee injury.

Southern began its comeback when back-up quarterback Joseph Dray scored on a five-yard touchdown run to cut the Hornets' lead to 27-23 with 7:59 left in the fourth. The score capped off a 5-play, 49-yard drive for the Jaguars.

After the Hornets failed to get a first down on their next possession, Southern scored on a special teams touchdown to regain the lead. Corey Cushingberry returned a punt by DSU freshman Marco Kano 64 yards to the endzone to give the Jags a 30-27 lead with 4:43 left to play.

Delaware State's next possession lasted just three plays. Glaud, who re-entered the game with six seconds left in the third quarter, had a pass attempt to Moore intercepted by Jason House with 3:08 left to play.

Three plays after the Delaware State turnover, Dray connected with Rashaun Allen on a four-yard touchdown pass to stretch Southern's lead to 37-27 with 1:50 remaining in the game.

Southern outgained Delaware State 394-320 in the contest. The Jaguars passed for 236 yards and rushed for 158. The Hornets collected 243 yards through the air and 77 on the ground.

Glaud completed 7 of 17 passes for 198 yards. He threw two touchdowns and was intercepted once. Elko connected on 2 of 4 passes for 45 yards and a touchdown. He was also intercepted once. Jaashawn Jones led the Hornets with 53 yards rushing on 11 carries, snapping a string of three 100-plus yard games. Delaware State's Andre Carroll led all players with a career-high 13 tackles. Quentin Ferguson added a career-high 10 tackles for the Hornets.

Martin Ukpai threw two touchdown passes, including the go-ahead score in the third quarter, to lead Florida A&M in the home opener for the Hornets.

Delaware State pulled ahead 12-10 when Jaashawn Jones capped off a 5-play, 56-yard drive with a one-yard touchdown run with 12:24 left in the third quarter. The big play in the drive was a 34-yard pass from Anthony Glaud to Larrone Moore to the Florida A&M 4-yard line. Anthony Glaud ran for two points on the conversion to give the Hornets a 14-10 lead.

The Rattlers needed just two plays on the ensuing possession to regain the lead. Ukpai connected with Brian Tymes on a 50-yard scoring pass to give the Rattlers a 17-14 lead with 11:23 left in the third quarter.

Each team had good scoring opportunities in the fourth quarter, but failed to convert.

Florida A&M opened the scoring when Trevor Scott capped off a 7-play, 54-yard drive with a 26-yard field goal on the opening drive of the game.

The Hornets used a long scoring drive to take the lead in the second quarter. The 8-play, 94-yard ended with an 11-yard scoring pass from Glaud to Darius Jackson to give DSU a 6-3 with 9:02 left in the second quarter. Glaud completed 4-of-5 passes during the drive, including a 39-yard hook up with Moore and 13 yards to Donnell Dixon. Jaashawn Jones also had a 12-yard run during the march.

The Hornets unsuccessfully attempted an extra point run following the touchdown due to a bad snap on the conversion.

Florida A&M pulled ahead 10-6 when Ukpai completed a 22-yard touchdown pass to Antonio Lawrence with 7:00 left in the third quarter.

Delaware State outgained Florida A&M 344- to-299.

Ukpai completed 12-of-27 passes for 161 yards for Florida A&M. Eddie Rocker led the Rattlers with 45 yards rushing.

Glaud connected on 14 of 31 passes for 192 yards for Delaware State. Moore had five catches for 102 yards for the Hornets. He also had 93 kickoff return yards to give him 195 all-purpose yards for the game. Moore is averaging 190.5 all-purpose yards in the Hornets' two-game this season.

Jones led DSU with 95 yards rushing.

Linebacker Kevin Green led the Hornets with nine tackles, including four solo stops. He also recovered a fumble and broke up a Florida A&M pass in the contest. John Sutton and Andre Carroll had five tackles each for DSU.

DELAWARE STATE 14 COASTAL CAROLINA 34

SEPT. 25, 2011
BROOKS STADIUM | CONWAY, S.C.

Coastal Carolina completely dominated the first half en route to the victory before a sellout crowd of 9,218 in its home opener.

The Chanticleers led 31-0 at halftime, and 34-0 late in the fourth quarter before DSU scored two touchdowns in the final 1:58 of the game to avoid being shutout for the first time since 2004, a span of 66 games.

The Hornets gained 97 yards in the fourth quarter to finish with 210 for the game. The Chanticleers racked up 339 total yards in the contest.

Coastal Carolina scored touchdowns on each of its first three possessions.

The Chanticleers opened the scoring when Zach MacDowell connected with Brandon Whitley on a five-yard touchdown pass with 9:26 left in the opening quarter. The 7-play, 65-yard drive was highlighted by a 38-yard run by Eric O'Neal to the Delaware State 27 on CCU's first play from scrimmage.

The Hornets' second possession ended on a fumble that was recovered by the Chanticleers at the DSU 34. Coastal Carolina needed six plays to pad its lead. Back-up quarterback Aramis Hillary capped off the six-play drive with a six-yard touchdown run to give the hosts a 14-0 lead with 4:35 left in the first quarter.

The Chanticleers used a trick play to open up a three-touchdown lead. Quarterback Zach MacDowell tossed the ball behind the line-of-scrimmage to wide receiver Dushawn Davis, who threw the ball to a wide open Brandon Whitley for a 24-yard touchdown to give CCU a 21-0 lead.

Delaware State's best drive of the first half ended in disaster as Coastal returned a blocked field goal attempt for its fourth touchdown. The Hornets drove 64 yards before stalling at the CCU two-yard line. Coastal's Josh Norman blocked an 18-yard field goal attempt by DSU's Mario Diaz-Aviles. Tarvorris Jolly scooped up the ball and returned it 94-yards for the touchdown to give the Chanticleers a 28-0 lead with 7:25 left in the second quarter.

Justin Durham nailed a 35-yard field goal on the final play of the first half to give Coastal Carolina a 31-0 lead at intermission.

Delaware State finally got on the board when quarterback Anthony Glaud directed an 80-yard scoring drive late in the game. Glaud capped off the drive with a one-yard touchdown run on fourth-and-goal with 1:58 left to play. The big play in the drive was a 22-yard completion on third down to Larrone Moore. Glaud connected with Donnell Dixon on a two-point pass to cut Coastal's lead to 34-8.

The Hornets recovered an onside kick on the ensuing kickoff that led to their second touchdown.

Glaud capped off the four-play, 50-yard drive with an eight-yard touchdown pass to Dixon to pull Delaware State to within 34-14 with 49 seconds left to play. The drive also featured an 11-yard pass to Jahmel Bashir and a 16-yarder to Justin Wilson. A two-point pass following the score was unsuccessful.

Glaud completed 22-of-25 passes (88.0%), mostly of the short variety, for 153 yards and one touchdown. Jaashawn Jones led the Hornets with 48 yards rushing on 12 carries.

Wilson, Bashir and Jackson each had four receptions to lead the Hornets. Wilson also had a team-high 38 receiving yards.

Defensively, Quinton Ferguson, Kevin Green and Francis Adjei led the Hornets with five tackles each. Green also recorded a sack, while Adjei and Matt Spicer had interceptions.

Freshman Antwon Chisholm rushed for 157 yards and a touchdown to lead the Pirates in a rain soaked nationally televised game (ESPN) Thursday evening contest. The game began in a downpour and was played in a steady rain throughout the contest.

The game was scoreless for nearly three quarters, although the Hornets had more scoring opportunities in the first half. Delaware State's Travis Tarpley returned the opening kickoff 78 yards to the Hampton 17, but the Hornets were stopped on downs at the Pirates' three yard line.

Hampton broke the scoreless tie when quarterback David Legree capped off a seven-play, 54-yard drive with a one-yard touchdown plunge to give the Pirates a 6-0 lead with 37 seconds left in the third quarter. The key play in the drive was a 32-yard run by Chisholm to the Delaware State five yard line. Rodrigo Hernandez missed the extra point kick.

The Hornets used a trick play to finally get on the board on their next possession. Wide receiver Darius Jackson took a swing pass from quarterback Anthony Glaud behind the line-of-scrimmage, then passed the ball to a wide open Justin Wilson in the endzone for a 23-yard touchdown to tie the game at 6-6 with 14:05 left in the fourth quarter. The extra point kick by Mario Diaz-Aviles gave the Hornets a 7-6 lead.

The touchdown catch was the second of the year for Wilson. Hampton regained the lead on its next possession. The Pirates marched 85 yards on nine plays, capped off by a 37-yard touchdown pass from Legree to Javariver Brown with 10:46 left to play. Legree completed a two-point pass to Reginald Hicks to give Hampton a 14-7 lead.

After Delaware State failed to score on its next possession, Chisholm gave the Pirates a 20-7 lead on a 57 yard touchdown run with 7:32 remaining in the game. The extra point kick was no good.

Delaware State pulled closer on a touchdown in the final minute. Back-up quarterback Nick Elko capped off an 8-play, 44-yard drive with a 23-yard touchdown pass to Donnell Dixon with 24 seconds left to play. Elko completed 4-of-7 passes for 44 yards during the drive. It was Dixon's second touchdown catch in the last two games.

The Hornets attempted an onside kick after the touchdown, but Hampton recovered the ball to secure the win.

Hampton won the total yardage battle, 341-to-263. The Pirates rushed for 258 yards, but were held to 83 yards passing. Delaware State had just 80 yards rushing, 78 by Jaashawn Jones. The Hornets passed for 183 yards. Wilson led DSU with career highs of six catches for 66 yards, while Travis Tarpley had a career-best four catches for 45 yards.

Andre Carrol led the Hornets with 12 tackles, including three behind the line-of-scrimmage, while Brandon Harvey had a career-high nine for DSU.

The Pirates overcame 14 penalties for 137 yards in the contest, while Delaware State was 0-for-4 in the red zone.

Bethune-Cookman racked up 590 yards en route to the victory before 10,151 homecoming fans.

The Wildcats improved 5-0 overall and pulled into a tie with Hampton for first place in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) with a 3-0 mark in league play. The Hornets fell to 0-5 and 0-3.

Delaware State scored 22 points and collected 291 yards in the second half after trailing 34-2 at the break.

Quarterback Matt Johnson completed 16-of-21 passes for 259 yards and a touchdown, and rushed for 52 yards and a score, to lead the Bethune-Cookman attack. Johnson was tops in the MEAC in passing average and total offense entering the contest.

Bethune-Cookman was forced to punt on its first three possessions of the game, but took advantage of a Delaware State special teams miscue to get on the board first.

After a bad punt snap gave Bethune-Cookman the ball at the DSU 25, Androse Bell capped off a three-play drive with a one-yard touchdown run to give the Wildcats a 6-0 lead with 4:23 left in the first quarter.

Delaware State's next possession also ended with a bad punt snap, giving the Wildcats the ball at the Hornets' 25. Six plays later, Andronicus Bell scored on a one-yard plunge to give BCU a 12-0 lead with 1:29 left in the opening quarter. The extra point kick was blocked. The ball was scooped up by Delaware State's Jonah Watson, who returned it all the way for two points for the Hornets.

Bethune-Cookman scored 22 unanswered points in the second quarter to open up a 34-2 lead at the half.

Johnson scored the Wildcats' first touchdown of the second quarter on a one-yard keeper. Isadore Johnson also scored a second quarter TD for the Cats on a 10-yard run, and Bell found the endzone for the second time in the game for BCU on a three-yard scamper.

Bethune-Cookman opened up a 40-2 lead when Johnson hooked up with a diving Jevaughn Reams on a 41-yard touchdown catch with 8:35 left in the third quarter.

Back-up quarterback Nick Elko engineered a drive that resulted in Delaware State's first touchdown of the game. Nick Williams capped off the three-play, 80-yard drive with a 22-yard touchdown run to cut BCU's lead to 40-9 with 2:44 left in the third quarter. It was the first career touchdown for Williams, who also had a 26-yard run during the drive. The scoring march also featured a 36-yard pass from Elko to tight end Jahmel Bashir.

Elko and wide receiver Larrone Moore connected for two touchdown passes in the fourth quarter. The pair hooked up on a 60-yard catch and run for a touchdown to cut Bethune-Cookman's lead to 40-16 with 12:10 left to play. Their second touchdown covered 26 yards with 2:43 remaining in the game.

It was the first time that Elko threw two touchdown passes, and Moore had two TD catches in a game.

Delaware State had 360 yards of total offense. Moore had four catches for 99 yards, while Justin Wilson hauled in four passes for 47 yards. Jaashawn Jones led all Hornet rushers with 71 yards on 10 carries, including a career-best 34 yard run.

DSU starting quarterback Anthony Glaud completed 12 of 24 passes for 127 yards, while Elko was successful on 5-of-7 throws for 109 yards off the bench.

Lineman Andre Carrol led the Hornets with 11 tackles, including seven solo stops. He has recorded double figures in tackles in three of the Hornets' five games, including the last two.

Delaware State celebrated a victory for the first time in 2010 after a 31-26 homecoming win over North Carolina A&T.

The Hornets improved to 1-5 overall and 1-3 in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC), while the Aggies fell to 0-7 and 0-4.

Jaashawn Jones rushed for a career-high 144 yards and a touchdown to lead the Delaware State attack. The Hornets racked up 351 yards in the contest, including 195 passing.

Delaware State quarterback Anthony Glaud completed 9-of-16 passes for 140 yards and two touchdowns. Nick Elko relieved Glaud for two possessions in the second quarter. He completed 3-of-5 passes for 55 yards, including a touchdown to Justin Wilson.

Darius Jackson led the Hornet receivers with four catches (48 yards). Wilson had three receptions for a career-high 77 yards. He also had two touchdown receptions for the first time in his career. Larrone Moore hauled in three passes for 62 yards and a touchdown for the Hornets.

Lineman Andre Caroll had a career-high 16 tackles to lead all players. Caroll had four tackles behind the line of scrimmage (-4.5 yards), including 1.5 sacks (-17). He also forced a fumble and recovered a fumble. Kevin Green had 11 tackles for the Hornets, including 2.5 backfield stops.

Mike Mayhew rushed for 132 yards and a touchdown for the Aggies, who collected 379 total yards. Mayhew was the MEAC's leading rusher with 590 yards (98.3 ypg) entering the contest. Mike Wallace led all players with five receptions for 86 yards for the Aggies.

North Carolina A&T used a 9-minute-40-second drive to open the scoring on the game's first possession. Mayhew capped off the 18-play, 72-yard drive with a one-yard plunge with 5:20 left in the first quarter. Sullivan Shidler's extra point kick gave the Aggies a 7-0 lead.

Delaware State answered with a touchdown on its first possession. Jones completed the 9-play, 67-yard drive with a 3-yard scoring run with 30 seconds left in the quarter. He had seven carries for 35 yards in the drive, which also featured a 23-yard pass from Glaud to Darius Jackson. The Hornets failed to tie the game when the extra point kick was unsuccessful.

The Aggies stretched their lead to 14-6 when Jeremy Graham intercepted a tipped pass by Glaud and returned it 50 yards for a touchdown with 12:26 left in the second quarter.

The Hornets pulled closer just before the end of the first half. Elko connected with Wilson on a 22-yard scoring pass to the NCAT 30. On the next play, Elko and Wilson hooked for a 30-yard touchdown with 20 seconds left in the second quarter. The Hornets failed on a two-point run following the score, allowing the Aggies to hold a 14-12 lead at intermission.

Glaud re-entered the game in the third quarter, and directed the Hornets to a go-ahead touchdown. He capped off a 5-play, 45-yard drive with a 25-yard touchdown pass to Wilson to give the Hornets their first lead, 18-14, with 2:04 left in the third quarter. DSU again came up short on an attempted two-point run following the score.

Delaware State opened up a little breathing room after an early fourth quarter touchdown. Glaud threw his second touchdown pass of the game, a 25-yard strike to Larrone Moore, to give the Hornets a 24-14 lead with 10:04 left in the contest. The 7-play, 80-yard drive also featured a 23-yard run by Jones and a 32-yard pass from Glaud to Moore. Mario Diaz-Aviles converted the extra point kick following the touchdown to give the Hornets an 11-point lead.

North Carolina A&T responded with a touchdown on the ensuing possession. Terrence Webb connected with Eldridge Cooper on a 9-yard scoring pass to pull the Aggies to within 25-20 with 7:24 remaining in the game. An attempted two-point run following the score was unsuccessful.

The Hornets scored off a North Carolina A&T turnover to open up a double-digit lead late in the game. Caroll forced a fumble on a sack of Aggie quarterback Webb. The ball was picked up by DSU's Olusegun Ayanbiola, who returned it 22 yards for a touchdown to give the Hornets a 31-20 lead with 2:13 left to play.

Morgan State scored the go-ahead touchdown with 20 seconds left to play, then added an insurance score off a turnover as time expired in a 34-24 MEAC win over Delaware State before 14,312 homecoming fans at Hughes Stadium.

The Hornets dropped to 1-6 overall and 1-4 in the MEAC, while the Bears won their second straight to improve to 4-3 and 3-1.

The game featured 10 turnovers, including six interceptions, three defensive touchdowns and a TD on a kickoff return.

Delaware State pulled ahead for the first time, 24-21, when freshman Mario Diaz-Aviles kicked a 32-yard field goal with 8:22 left to play. It was the first field goal of his collegiate career, and first for the Hornets this season.

After the teams exchanged punts, Morgan State began the game-winning drive at its 15-yard line with 3:24 left to play. Quarterback Delonte Williams connected with Tyrone Hendrix on a 34-yard touchdown with 20 seconds remaining in the game. Hendrix caught the ball inside the five yard line, and broke two tackles before fighting his way into the endzone.

Delaware State's final possession ended when Morgan's Sheldon Jacques forced a fumble on a sack of Hornet quarterback Anthony Glaud, and returned the ball two yards into the endzone on the last play of the game.

The Hornets trailed 21-7 before Jaashawn Jones scored on a career-best 48-yard run with 12:33 left in the third quarter. Delaware State tied the game when defensive tackle Darrell Brown recovered a fumble in the endzone on the first play of the fourth quarter.

DSU scored its first touchdown of the game when defensive back Matt Spicer intercepted a pass from Williams as he was being sacked, and returned it nine yards into the endzone.

The Hornets committed a season-high six turnovers in the game, three on Glaud interceptions. Morgan State's Chris Flowers also returned the second half kickoff 73 yards for a touchdown to give the Bears a 21-7 lead.

The teams were nearly even in yardage. Delaware State out-gained the Bears 389-to-382 in total yards. The Hornets passed for a season high 295 yards. Glaud completed 17 of 24 passes for 216 yards, while Nick Elko came off the bench to connect on 8 of 11 throws for 82 yards.

Jones rushed for a game-high 119 yards on 22 carries. It was his second straight 100-yard performance. Delaware State wide receiver Travis Tarpley had a career-high seven catches for 64 yards. Darius Jackson hauled in five passes for a game-high 88 yards.



Hornet linebackers Kevin Green and Brandon Harvey led all players with 11 tackles each. Harvey also had a 32-yard fumble return. DSU's Andre Carrol had seven tackles, including two sacks, and an interception.

Larrone Moore had three catches for 38 yards to pass the 100 reception mark at DSU. He is now ninth on the Hornets' career list with 102 catches.

Delaware State scored two defensive touchdowns in a game for the first time since a 62-0 win Concord (WV) in 2006.

The Hornets committed just two penalties for 10 yards in the contest, each a season low.

DSU back-up quarterback Nick Elko handled punting duties for the second straight game due to a knee injury to regular punter Marco Kano. Elko averaged 45.0 yards on three kicks, including one for a career-best 54 yards.

South Carolina State scored touchdowns on offense, defense and special teams in a 38-21 victory over Delaware State in a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference game at Alumni Stadium.

The nationally-ranked Bulldogs won their second straight to improve to 6-2 overall and 4-1 in the MEAC. The Hornets dropped their second in a row to fall to 1-7 and 1-5.

South Carolina State is No. 17 in the latest major polls of Football Championship Subdivision teams. The Bulldogs also defeated the Hornets for the third straight year to open up a 25-15 lead in the series.

SC State racked up 464 total yards, including 253 on the ground. Redshirt sophomore Chris Merrill rushed for a career-high 160 yards and two touchdowns in his first start. Quarterback Malcolm Long completed 18-of-33 passes for 200 yards. He threw one touchdown and one interception.

Delaware State had 325 total yards, including 282 through the air. Quarterback Anthony Glaud connected on 19-of-30 passes for 169 yards. He had one touchdown pass, but was intercepted twice. Linebacker David Erby returned a Glaud interception for a touchdown to give the Bulldogs a second quarter lead. Nick Elko came off the bench to complete 7-of-12 passes for 113 yards and a touchdown for the Hornets.

Justin Wilson had nine catches for 131 yards, each a career high and tops for a DSU receiver in a game this season.

The Hornets opened the scoring when Glaud connected with Wilson on a 22-yard touchdown pass on the game's opening drive. The seven-play drive began at the SC State 42 after a 53-yard return by Larrone Moore on the opening kickoff of the game. The extra point kick by Mario Diaz-Aviles gave Delaware State a 7-0 lead with 11:18 left in the first quarter. Wilson leads the Hornets with five touchdown catches this season.

South Carolina State evened the game when Long hit tight end Antoine Kerr for a 50-yard touchdown pass with 5:09 left in the second quarter.

On the ensuing Delaware State possession, Erby intercepted a pass by Glaud and raced 46 yards down the sideline for a touchdown to give the Bulldogs a 14-7 lead with 4:18 to go before halftime.

South Carolina State led 17-7 when Lataris Douglas blocked a punt by Delaware State's Nick Elko, and returned the ball 15 yards for a touchdown. Blake Erickson's extra point after the score gave the Bulldogs a 24-7 lead with 5:04 left in the third quarter.

Delaware State pulled closer on a touchdown early in the fourth quarter on a drive directed by Elko. Travis Tarpley hauled in a 17-yard touchdown pass from Elko in the corner of the endzone to cut the Bulldog's lead to 24-14 with 14:24 left to play. The touchdown catch was the first of year for Tarpley.

The Bulldogs answered with a touchdown on their next possession.

Three plays after a 37-yard kickoff return by Derrick Wiley gave SC State the ball at the DSU 44, Merrill scampered into the endzone from 23 yards out to give the Bulldogs a 31-14 lead.

Delaware State used an impressive drive to pull to within 10 points midway through the fourth quarter. Reserve running back James Rosseau capped off a 12-play, 91-yard drive with a 1-yard touchdown run to cut the Bulldogs' lead to 31-21 with 8:11 left to play.

Elko completed passes of 28 and 22 yards to Wilson, and ran 10 yards for a first down during the drive.

SC State closed out the scoring on a 12-yard run by Merrill with 5:29 left in the game.

Delaware State's defense had a season-best performance in a 29-7 win over North Carolina Central in the 2010 home finale for the Hornets at Alumni Stadium.

The Hornets improved to 2-7 on the season, while Eagles fell to 3-6.

Delaware State allowed season-lows of 134 total yards and 21 rushing yards in the contest. The Hornets also recorded a season-high six sacks, including a career-best 3.5 by sophomore end Olusegun Ayanbiola.

Hornet quarterback Anthony Glaud, playing in his final home game, completed 16-of-20 passes for 224 yards and a touchdown. Wide receiver Justin Wilson had eight catches for 129 yards, his second straight 100+-yard game. He entered the contest as the MEAC leader in receiving yards.

Sophomore James Rosseau rushed for a career-high 86 yards and two touchdowns in his first start for the Hornets. DSU scored the final 22 points of the game after the teams were tied 7-7 in the first quarter.

Delaware State opened the scoring when Glaud capped off a four-play, 61-yard drive with a one-yard touchdown plunge with 10:43 left in the first quarter. Rosseau had two carries for 38 yards during the drive. The extra point by Mario Diaz-Aviles gave the Hornets a 7-0 lead.

North Carolina Central tied the game on the ensuing possession. Michael Johnson connected with Geovonie Irvine on a 14-yard touchdown pass with 5:53 left in the opening quarter.

The Hornets regained the lead, 13-7, on a one-yard touchdown run by Rosseau with 13:20 left in the second quarter. The six-play, 50-yard drive was highlighted by a 28-yard pass from Glaud to Wilson to the NCCU 16. The extra point kick was unsuccessful.

Delaware State stretched its lead to 16-7 when Diaz-Aviles kicked his second field goal of the season, a 32-yarder, with 28 seconds left in the second quarter.

The Hornets opened up a 23-7 lead on a two-yard touchdown pass from Glaud to Darius Jackson with 8:33 left in the third quarter. Glaud completed four-of-four passes for 49 yards, including a 25-yarder to Jackson, during the 10-play drive.

Delaware State took advantage of a North Carolina Central turnover deep in its own territory to complete the scoring. Three plays after the Eagles lost a fumble on their four-yard line, Rosseau scored on a one-yard run to give the Hornets a 29-7 lead with 2:21 left in the third quarter.

Norfolk State racked up 459 yards, including 310 on the ground, in a 31-21 win at Dick Price Stadium.

The Spartans won their third straight to improve to 5-5 overall and 4-4 in the MEAC. The Hornets fell to 2-8 and 1-6.

Senior DeAngelo Branche rushed for a season-high 212 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Spartan attack. He surpassed the 1,000-yard mark for the season during the contest.

Delaware State quarterback Anthony Glaud completed 20-of-36 passes for season-highs of 289 yards and three touchdowns. Justin Wilson had seven catches for 92 yards and two touchdowns, while Donnell Dixon hauled in six passes for a career-high 97 yards.

Norfolk State opened the scoring when Branche capped off a 6-play, 35-yard drive with an 11-yard touchdown run with 7:39 left in the first quarter.

The Spartans used a long drive to stretch their lead to 14-0. Branche scored his second touchdown of the game on a 15-yard run to complete a 13-play, 87 yard drive with 11:38 left in the third quarter.

The Hornets cut Norfolk State's lead in half when Glaud and Wilson hooked up on a 25-yard scoring strike with 7:50 left in the second quarter.

The Spartans opened up a 24-7 lead after a touchdown pass late in the second quarter and a fourth quarter field goal.

Glaud connected on fourth quarter scoring passes to Nick Williams (three yards) and Wilson (16 yards) to close out the Delaware State scoring.

It marked the second time this season that Wilson had two touchdown catches in a game. He now leads all MEAC receivers in catches (50), receiving yards (720) and touchdown catches (7).

Three Delaware State players reached double figures in tackles. Linebacker Brandon Harvey led all players with 12 tackles (9 solo), while defensive back Matt Spicer and lineman Andre Caroll had 10 each. Delaware State Jamal Porcher had his first career interception for DSU.
